As the need for integrating counselling and IAPT psychological services increases, demand has also increased for supervisors who can not only supervise counsellors but also other IAPT practitioners.

This course is designed in the clinical supervision tradition of reflective practice and framed within the NHS context and as such will prepare participants to work with all modalities in a multi-disciplinary framework.

Commencing March 2011, CPC's One Year Post Graduate Diploma Course will take place on 10 Saturdays, monthly throughout the year. The Course will:

- Meet training standards for supervision in line with CPC & the training requirement of BAPPS (90 hrs)
- Meet specialist NHS requirements for supervision
- Be suitable for experienced NHS counsellors and psychotherapists from a range of theoretical models of practice
- Provide the general skills and competencies for professional clinical supervision
- Provide an understanding of the NHS organisation and context
- Clarify the roles of therapy, supervision and management
- Examine the interface between the psychological and the medical paradigm and its impact on clinical work in the NHS
- Develop an awareness of organisational, ethical, and legal issues relating to supervision in the NHS context
- Comprise theoretical seminars and supervised supervision groups
- Consider the implications of clinical supervision within IAPT models of service provision
