Dr. Jane McChrystal is a UKCP Registered Psychotherapeutic Counsellor. She has worked in Primary Care since 1991 and is an experienced trainer and teacher of counsellors.

Her research into the effects of bereavement was inspired by working with people who had experienced loss within a Primary Care setting and discussions with other health care professionals. A longstanding interest in John Bowlby's Attachment Theory led to a study of the links between insecure attachment, bereavement and health and resulted in the award of a doctorate in psychology in 2004.

She is now using her research findings to write and teach about the psychological needs of bereaved people. She hopes to encourage health care professionals, including Counsellors and Nurses, to consider the significance of attachment issues in their work with those who have experienced loss.



The aim of the workshop is to help therapists use attachment theory to work more effectively with clients who have experienced loss.

Participants will gain a grounding in recent developments in attachment theory and research and their practical application to working with bereaved people.

They will have the opportunity to reflect on their own attachment style and its possible impact on the counselling relationship.

This workshop should appeal to anybody who enjoys learning through integrating taught material with clinical and personal experience.
