Jan Sutton: Author, trainer, counsellor. A leading advocate for better understanding and treatment of self-injury. Jan also maintains the SIARI website which provides many helpful suggestions and assists caregivers.

The conference will also include a therapist and supervisor presenting their own clinical experience of dealing with suicide
